

## **CA Conference Bursary Rate for CA2022 (Swansea)**

This conference will be a hybrid event, allowing in-person attendance from Saturday to Monday at a fee of £48 per day and online attendance of £29 per day. Events on Friday, April 8 will be free to attend.

The CA has been exploring ways to facilitate attendance by those who lack the necessary funds to pay the standard conference fees. We are pleased to announce that we are offering a reduced bursary rate of £29 for the whole conference to the following categories of delegate:

- PhD Students based at universities in the UK and RoI unable to secure full funding from their host institutions;
- Schoolteachers based in the UK and RoI unable to secure full funding from their schools;
- Individuals whose papers have been accepted, but who are not affiliated to a UK Classics department and who lack necessary funding.

This scheme will essentially operate on a trust basis. On registration, those claiming the bursary rate will simply be required to provide details of their job or thesis title and institutional affiliation, as appropriate, and state their eligibility to claim a reduced fee, i.e. by asserting their inability to secure the necessary funds from their institutions or employers.

Those claiming the bursary rate can opt to attend the conference either online or in person. Please note that all delegates opting to attend the conference in person will be responsible for their own travel or accommodation costs.

Registration for the conference will be open in the New Year, and details will be published in due course.
